### Aims & Objectives


#### Language

The medium of instruction and communication is English. Fluency in English is considered as a vital requirement for all. Students leaving the school wish to join institutions and colleges in various parts of the country and the world and English gives them access to modern knowledge not yet readily available in Indian languages, particularly in the areas of Science and Technology. English language gives an edge to them in the present scenario of globalisation.

Yet, Hindi being the national language, holds a very important place in the curriculum. Every effort is made to ensure that each child attains a high standard in it.

#### Staff & Facilities

In its pursuit of excellence, the institution has a qualified and experienced body of teaching staff. The strength of the class is kept low to give individual attention to each student and build up a personal rapport with them. the staff members employ audio-visual teaching aids—Computers, T.V., Video, Science Park, Cassette Players, and LCD Projector, to supplement the material provided in text books. Such aids are adopted for teaching English, Maths, Environmental Sciences & Rhymes, since they give students a much wider perspective of the course and promote a sense of inquiry and discourse.



The kindergarten programme in the school is designed to meet the special needs of the children. It provides for these special needs in a child-centered environment. Daily opportunities are provided to the tiny tots to choose from a wide range of activities and experiences.

Handwork–Paper cutting, tearing, pasting, folding and mosaic, thread and spray painting, activities with button and popcorn, and a variety of other activities are some of the handwork taught to the children.

Drawing–Free hand drawing gives wings to the children's often wildly imaginative figures and lovely colour combinations. It gives the children an aesthetic sense and sensitivity. Colouring helps them to learn to use their fingers just as child takes tottering footsteps before learning to walk properly–the same way they turn their first shaky strokes into formal lines. This helps them in confidence building.

Celebrating festivals–For the children to imbibe the concept of secularism, unity in diversity and nationalism, national as well as religious festivals are celebrated in the school. Students dress up as national leaders, make national flags and rakhis, paint diyas on Diwali. They also celebrate Holi, Gandhi Jayanti, Independence Day and Christmas.

Music & Rhymes–Music soothes the soul and helps to chanelise the energy of the students. Therefore, group singing of rhymes is encouraged. Children dance on the music. English and Hindi recitation competitions are organized. A variety of songs, based on festivals and patriotism are taught.

Stories–The school has a library with plenty of books with bright and colourful illustrations. Books transmit the children to the land of fantasy in the formative years. The stories are narrated by the teachers with the visual help of the puppets, masks and dramatization. The children are given free hand to act out of the stories in their own way during Hindi and English story telling competitions and also during the enacting of various fairy tales characters.



Outdoor Activities–A healthy body means a healthy mind. the students are taken outdoor to play games so that hey develop team spirit and good fellowship. They take part in physical training and aerobics which makes them disciplined and physically strong.

Picnics and outings – During the year, tours and excursions are organized. Children visit places of interest like the Zoo, the Museum, Children's park and Children's movie. Education is combined with entertainment.

General Knowledge – Children learn concepts related to environment, self, home and nation through talks and project work. Children are quizzed on the knowledge of their country, on numbers, people and places. The lush green plants and trees and well mowed lawns provide plentiful opportunities for nature walks much enjoyed by he children. This helps the children to widen their horizon, to be aware of heir nature and surroundings.

School Functions–We also organize Sports/Annual Function and Carnival, which is held on large scale and in which care is taken to ensure the participation of all the children.

#### Philosophy

Ours is a completely secular institution that instills into its students, a deep regard for Indian traditions and customs. Children are free to practice any religion of their choice, and the school celebrates all major festivals with equal joy and reverence. Prayers from different religions are chanted on the occasions like Gandhi Jayanti.

The school believes in exposing the children to different faith and beliefs so that they may become responsible, cultured and dedicated individuals.

It is, therefore, our primary aim to strive to bring out the best, not only in academics and sports arena, but more so in their character. Since children spend their formative years in the school, the environment in which they grow is of tremendous significance.
